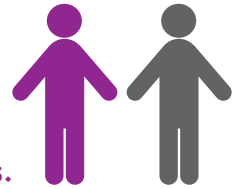

## 60% OF UTAH'S YOUTH

are not enrolled in preschool. Without access to quality preschool, low-income kids, African-American and Latino children, are far less likely to be prepared to start kindergarten than their peers.



## STUDIES SHOW THOSE WHO ATTENDED PRESCHOOL ARE

- 20%** More likely to raise their socioeconomic status
- 28%** Less likely to abuse drugs or alcohol later in life
- 28%** Less likely to end up in jail



Every **\$1** invested in preschool saves tax payers up to **\$13** in future costs

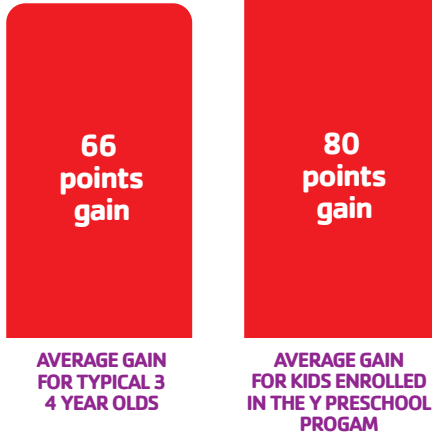

## BOOSTING SKILLS REACHING MILESTONES

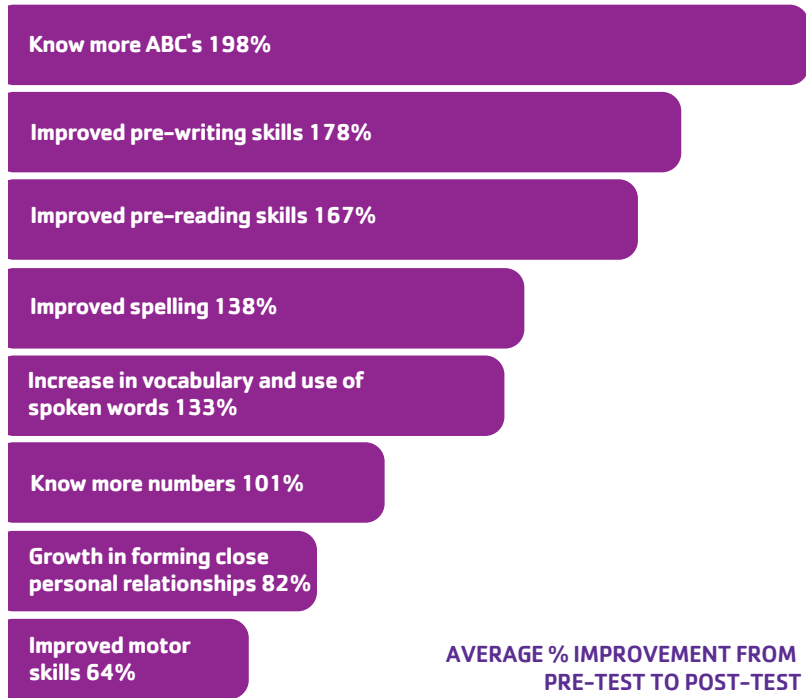
**85%** of youth start the Y Preschool Program behind developmentally. Development milestones track the skills children gain over time.

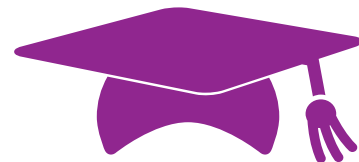
AVERAGE % IMPROVEMENT FROM PRE-TEST TO POST-TEST
