A SEAT AT THE TABLE FOR ALL

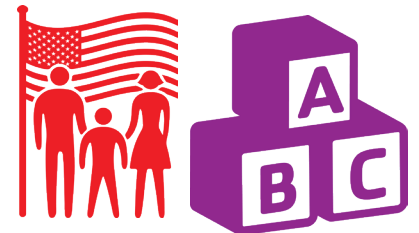
We believe that ALL children should have a seat at a table with a healthy meal. In 2019, we served 258,378 meals to children ages to 3-18 years old at 20 program sites.

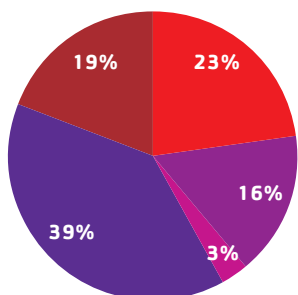

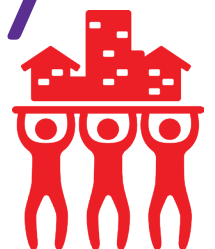
